- Units represent interests in the Issuer's Stock Fund, which are payable in cash. The reporting person's interests in the Issuer's Stock Fund fluctuate with the fund's performance. The information in this report is based on a plan statement dated as of September 30, 2013.
- Options vested in three annual installments as follows: 33% on February 4, 2009; 33% on February 4, 2010; and 34% on February 4, 2011.
- Options vested in three annual installments as follows: 33% on February 19, 2010; 33% on February 18, 2011; and 34% on February 17, 2012.
- Options vested in three annual installments as follows: 33% on February 22, 2011; 33% on February 22, 2012; and 34% on February 22, 2013.
- 18,044 options are vested and 9,296 will vest on February 24, 2014.
- 7,817 options are vested; 7,818 will vest on February 24, 2014 and 8,055 will vest on February 23, 2015.
